Dear Parents of High School Students,

We would like to let you know about an opportunity available to all eligible Florida students. The State of Florida offers **The Bright Futures Scholarship** to students who fulfill the requirements set forth by the Department of Education.

One of the requirements concerns curriculum. **Students wishing to apply for the scholarship must fill out the enclosed curriculum list. The curriculum list will need to be submitted to Allendale Academy for review by the School Director. Changes in curriculum will need to be submitted in writing or via email.** It is not necessary to list books used for dual enrolled courses, FLVS courses, courses taken at previous schools or courses taught by a certified teacher. If more than one book is used for any one course, just list the core curriculum used.

To be considered for the program, students must return the Curriculum List to Allendale by the end of their first semester of high school enrollment. The Initial Application must be sent to Allendale by the end of December of their senior year.

We encourage you to read through the enclosed brochure. Please let us know if you have any questions about the scholarship. It will be your responsibility to stay informed about the requirements and qualifications to remain eligible for the scholarship. We will inform you of changes as we become aware of them.

It is very important that you send us your student's 12th grade report cards as promptly as possible so we can enter the information online with the DOE. The sooner we enter the information, the sooner your student will receive notification from the DOE of their status concerning the scholarship.
